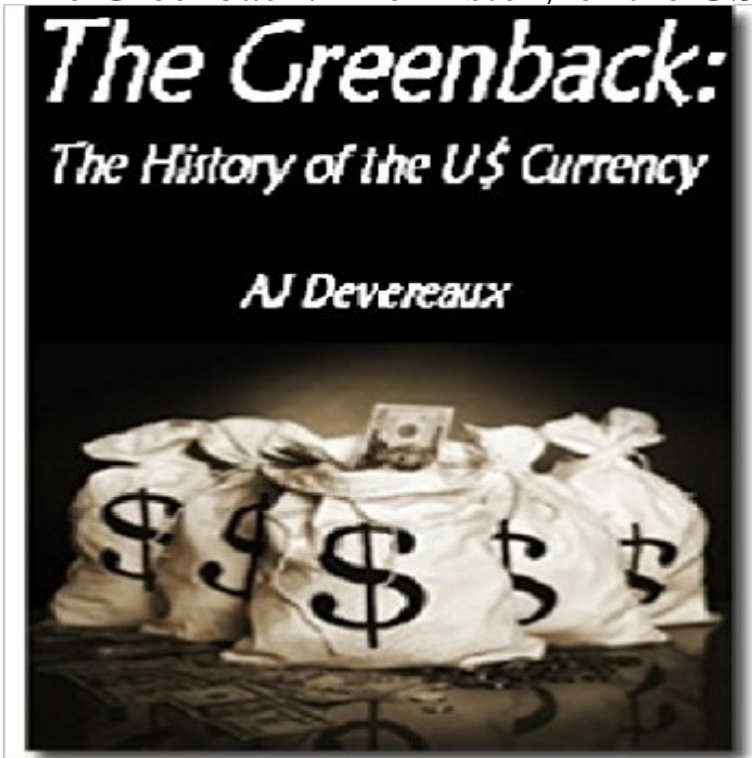


The Greenback: The History of the US Currency
